BREAKING NEWS; COVID Vaccine or Negative Test Requirement Added to VAB Hall of Fame & Awards Banquet...


Although its exciting to be together again in person, the recent rise in positive COVID-19 cases in Vermont cannot be ignored. The safety of our members and guests is our top priority. Therefore, **all attendees will be required to show proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 or a negative PCR test from the past 72 hours.** The wearing of facial masks is welcome, but not mandatory.

If you have already registered and would like a refund, please email vab@vab.org.

To expedite the screening process at the event, you and your guest are encouraged to email a photo of your COVID vaccination card to vab@vab.org no later than Friday 12/3 at 5pm. You will then be emailed a "pre-checked" pass with your name on it that when shown to security upon arrival, will enable you to by-pass screening.

A COVID PCR test must be administered by an authorized provider with your name included on the test result. Vermont PCR testing is free and locations can be found [here](#).

Rewind 92.7 (WKVT) in Brattleboro will be adding a live Digital Broadcast on "Giving Tuesday" November 30th to support "**Project Feed the Thousands**" – Southern Vermont's largest food drive.

"We are so honored to be working with Project Feed again this year and doing something a little bit different. "Giving Tuesday" was the perfect day to highlight what our community does every year for the food insecure." – says Operations Manager Scott Antonivich. "Project Feed the Thousands has been critical in efforts to help those who are food insecure, and a lot of our local communities are seeing double the need this year. We wanted to use our traditional terrestrial radio signal and add a digital element to support the efforts. We've interviewed handfuls of people who have supported the efforts of "Project Feed the Thousands", toured some of the food shelves, spoke with those who are "food insecure" and incorporated clients and listeners into a LIVE stream that will run simultaneously on Facebook, YouTube, LinkedIn, and TikTok during the entire day on "Giving Tuesday" November 30th. Think of it like a Rewind TV focused on online donations for Project Feed the Thousands."

From local businesses, listeners, and a few politicians...the Rewind staff are hopeful that their channel will make a big impact this year.

"For years, I've been involved in collecting food donations during live broadcasts and I am very passionate about it." said Antonivich. "COVID required us to pivot last year and we discovered that we can generate a lot of online donations using our resources. This year Project Feed has a goal of \$100,000 and they'll need every dime. The pandemic is still causing these food shelves to be stretched as far as they can."

Llu Mulvaney-Stanak Named WGDR/WGDH Station Manager

Six months into its independence as a community-owned radio station, WGDR/WGDH has hired a new Station Manager, Llu Mulvaney-Stanak. This role will oversee all aspects of the station, as well as provide key leadership for CVCR as a nonprofit.

"The Board of Central Vermont Community Radio is thrilled to start working with Llu in their newly added capacity as station manager at WGDR," said Mark Michaelis, Chair of the CVCR Board. "Llu's extensive experience in both the nonprofit and radio world is a unique combination that's rare to find, and one that will serve our listeners well as we start another new chapter in WGDR's long history. We couldn't be more excited about WGDR's future with Llu at the helm!"

Mulvaney-Stanak (who uses they/them pronouns) got their start in community radio on WGDR/WGDH as a Barre City teenager in the 1990s. For the last 20 years, they have led non-profits, worked in higher education, and managed political campaigns across the state. Their work has spanned a range of community issues including community media, youth advocacy, LGBTQ+ rights, and fostering of arts and culture.

Mulvaney-Stanak has also been on the air on Vermont radio for almost 30 years on community, college, and commercial radio. Known as "DJ Llu," they hosted 99.9 the Buzz's long-standing new music show for a decade, helped co-found WBTV-LP, the newest low-power community radio station in Burlington, and have produced the popular weekly show, "Get Fresh with DJ Llu" for 17 years on UVM's WRUV. Mulvaney-Stanak comes to WGDR/WGDH after consulting for a number of non-profits on strategy and high-level roles in political campaigns in the last year.

In their return to the station Mulvaney-Stanak remarked, "I am deeply grateful to WGDR/WGDH for

sparkling a love of radio in me at such a young age and I'm honored to help the station establish itself as community-owned. I'm excited by the possibilities for future programming and community engagement through the station."
